
CAN'T JOIN US BUT WANT TO PARTICIPATE? HERE'S OUR MARCH WORKOUT PLAN:

Each session should take about 20 to 30 minutes, three times a week. Be sure to space out these three days throughout the week to give yourself a chance to rest and recover between efforts. And, don't worry about how fast you're going. Running faster can wait until your bones are stronger, and your body is fitter. For now, focus on gradually increasing the time or distance you run or walk.

Workout days: Monday/Wednesday/Friday

Weeks 1 & 2: Brisk, five-minute warm-up walk. Then, alternate 60 seconds of jogging and 90 seconds of walking for a total of 20 minutes.

Weeks 3 & 4: Brisk, five-minute warm-up walk. Then, alternate 90 seconds of jogging and two minutes of walking for a total of 20 minutes.



A FRIENDLY REMINDER FROM YOUR HOA: PALMS BY THE POOL...NOT BY THE FRONT DOOR

Just a reminder that palm trees are permitted in residents' back yards only. To protect the architectural continuity of Tuscan Lakes, residents must submit an application for approval by the ARC prior to installation. This insures that the type of palm tree(s) they wish to plant, along with the desired location, are both permitted by the community guidelines. Queen palms are not permitted within Tuscan Lakes.
