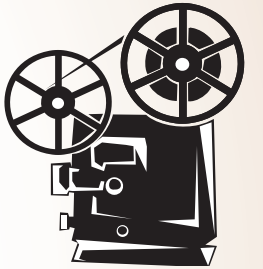

CAMP BY THE CREEK

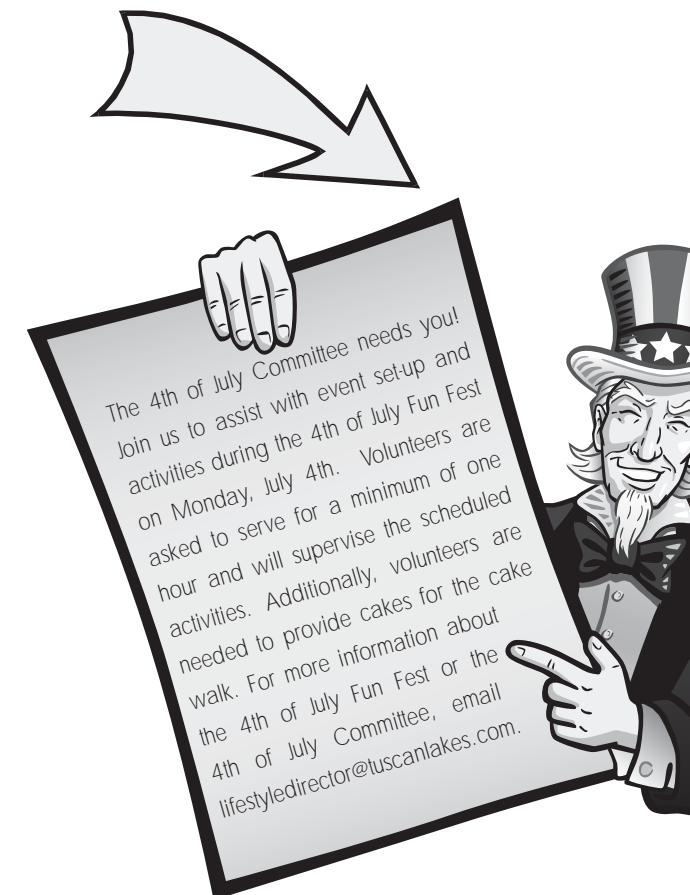

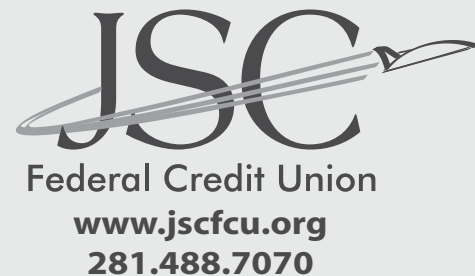

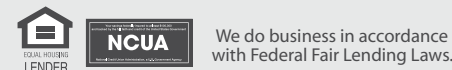

GATORS AT TUSCAN LAKES?


Yep... alligators! League City Animal Control and the Texas Parks & Wildlife Dept. (TPWD) recently visited Tuscan Lakes after reported sightings of small alligators in our lake system. Those two critters were reportedly removed by the game warden.

How did alligators get in the lakes? The TPWD says that alligators are common along Clear Creek and the Gulf Coast. According to the game warden, the prolonged drought conditions have contributed to alligators migrating up the streams, channels and bayous that feed into Clear Creek in search of other water bodies.

So what now? Well, now that we know that the alligators can make their way into our lake system, we all need to be aware that these reptiles may be present. For the most part, the game warden says that alligators are fearful of and more often than not, will turn away from humans. The best plan of action if you encounter an alligator, or a snake, is one of avoidance. Residents should be mindful of where they are walking, keep pets on their leashes in accordance with League City leash laws, and avoid tall grasses and the edge of lakes where alligators and snakes may sun themselves. The game warden says to never, ever feed or antagonize an alligator. Feeding an alligator is prohibited by State law.

New signs will be going up soon around the lakes to alert residents of the possible presence of alligators and to caution residents not to swim in the lake system.


Please note that the Tuscan Lakes Community Association does not remove or schedule the removal of reptiles or animals. If you see an alligator, you are encouraged to contact Texas Parks and Wildlife Dept. at 281.842.8100.
